**Double S Ranch Organic Recovery Project
Second Quarterly Report Summary of 2004 Activities**

Progress on the Double S Ranch Organic Recovery Project in Sumterville has progressed rapidly in the second quarter of 2004. Most recently a new John Deere Tractor (\$50K+) was purchased and prior to that the fencing project began (\$60K+) along with the acquisition of cattle (\$20K+) and feeding troughs (\$7K+). In addition, grinding equipment (which will be financed) for food cases as well as scales (financed also) is soon to be acquired. Feedstock, such as citrus pulp waste, has already been moved to the facility with the first deliveries of food waste to begin next week.

All of the above has been accomplished by the Ranch Manager, Bob Stossel, who was hired to oversee this project for Organic Matters, Inc. In early July Bob attended the Florida Cattlemen's Association Convention addressed Cattlemen regarding the FORCE/Organic Matters Inc Project in Sumterville. As a result of this meeting, cattlemen expected to visit the site soon.

Mr. Stossel's responsibilities to the FORCE/OMI Project will continue to the project completion, ensuring all data is submitted and compliance with FORCE, for the Project, is completed.
