




Florida Municipal Solid Waste Collected (50.7 million tons)




Solid Waste Management in FL (1988-2022)

FL's organics recovery primarily focuses on the production and use of yard waste by REGISTERED facilities.

In 2022, Florida had a TOTAL of 380 organics registered and permitted recycling facilities that received 3.6 million tons of organics that were diverted.
