

FL Organics Recycling (1988 - 2001)



- Solid Waste Mgt. Act Passed by Legislature (1988)
- 1988 Yard Waste Landfill Ban (YWLB)
- Started as Mulching State (prior to 1988)
- FL DEP Active Permitting Staff (Francine Joyal)
- FORA FL Organics Recycling Association (early 90s)
- RFT Organics Committee, DOT Outreach, and ELS Events, etc.
- University Research, UF IFAS Compositing Research
- FORCE Established by the Legislature in (2001)

FL Organics Recycling (2002 - 2010) continued.



- 75% Recycling Goal set by FL Leg (2008)
- Revised Organics Recycling Facilities Rule Chapter 62-709 is adopted (Feb 2010)
- FL LEG Repeals the YWLB (June 2010)
 - FL Governor Vetoes the YWLB (June 2010)
 - LEG Overturned the YWLB (Dec. 2010)
- Private Organics Recycling Facilities Emergence in FL (2010) & Subsequent Shift

- FORCE Website Clearinghouse of Information (2011)
- EPA Shifts focus to Food Waste Reduction Prioritization
- DACS Wasted Food Reduction Prioritization in FL
- FL DEP Active Permitting Staff (Lauren O'Connor)






Solid Waste Management in FL (1996 – 2020)
